The Commission is asking Young People to nominate themselves for this position. Young people who wish to go should be active in both their local congregations and in the Presbytery of Mid-Kentucky.

Please provide the information that is requested, keeping in mind the following:

1. The individual must be between 17 and 23 years old on the date the General Assembly convenes.
2. The individual must be able to attend the full meeting of the General Assembly, dates stated above. Usually YAADs arrive 1-2 days before General Assembly begins for orientation.
3. The Commission will be nominating one delegate and one alternate.
4. All individuals will be considered for the 226th General Assembly (2024) only. Alternates will not automatically become delegates in 2026.
5. All applications must be returned to the Presbytery office by August 22, 2023.
