## Mid-Kentucky Presbytery Application to be a Commissioner to the 226th General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) June 25 - July 4, 2024 Process approved by vote of Presbytery 11/11/2023

The Commission on Nominations will select one Minister of Word and Sacrament and one Ruling Elder for election by the Presbytery of Mid-Kentucky to serve as the presbytery's commissioners to the General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.). Election will take place at the November meeting of the presbytery the year before the General Assembly meets (November 2023 for the 2024 General Assembly).

Ministers and Ruling Elders interested in serving as commissioners must apply to serve. The Commission on Nominations will select one minister and one ruling elder for election by the presbytery from among those who apply. The Commission on Nominations will determine deadlines for applications.

Ministers and Ruling Elders who wish to serve as commissioners must be active in their congregation and in the Presbytery of Mid-Kentucky. Service at the Synod and General Assembly levels of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) is also desirable. Years of ordained service and years of service in the Presbytery of Mid-Kentucky will be taken into consideration but will not be determinative in the selection process.

Service as a General Assembly commissioner is rigorous, requiring many hours of preparation and orientation prior to the General Assembly, long hours of service during the meeting of the General Assembly, and a commitment to interpret the work of the General Assembly to the presbytery and its congregations (upon request) after the General Assembly. Those wishing to serve should take these responsibilities into consideration when applying.

Note: the 226th General Assembly meets in Salt Lake City, UT, June 25 - July 4, 2024.
